# Teaching Philosophy

Welcome! I look forward to us working together. I offer weekly 30, 45, and 60 minute lessons.

Every student is unique, responds differently to music, and deserves a positive learning experience. As your teacher, I will guide you throughout your musical journey and foster a passion for the guitar.

My teaching style combines classical technique with classical and contemporary repertoire. We will learn the fundamentals of concrete classical technique that will apply to virtually any style of music. This includes posture, sound production, reading music, performance tips, and other facets of becoming a well-rounded musician.

# What can you expect from me?

- Tailored lesson plans that promote a successful pace for each individual
- Positive, constructive teaching style
- An encouraging learning environment
- Feedback on student progress

## What do I expect from my students?

- A desire to learn guitar
- A respectful, receptive, and positive mindset
- Dedication to practicing the assigned materials each week
- Open communication regarding goals, expectations, and progress

## **Practicing**

Developing a consistent, daily habit of spending time with your instrument is the key to success. Scheduled practice time needs to be purposely set aside on a daily basis.

A small amount of practice with mental focus is superior to a large amount of practice when the mind is not engaged. It's helpful to end every practice session with something that is enjoyable to play. It is encouraged that the student keep a practice log in a designated notebook to record what they accomplished and what can be improved upon.

#### Recitals

Recitals are a great way to celebrate each other's achievements. Having a goal to work towards creates a growth mindset leading to accelerated learning and success. We will have at least two recitals each year; one in the Fall and one in the Spring. Every student is encouraged to participate as performing is an integral part about playing music. For those who wish to not play in public, we can arrange a private performance.

## Calendar/Scheduling

There are year-round lessons. This means that, aside from the dates mentioned below, lessons are still given on days that school may take off (e.g. Veterans Day, Presidents' Day, Spring Break, etc.)

When you sign up for lessons, you are reserving that time slot for the **entire year** – please keep this in mind when you book your time slot. Your lesson time and day will only change during the summer unless you reach out to me directly for a request to change your lesson time - summer lessons begin and end based on the first and last day of school.

# No lessons will be given:

Thanksgiving Break (November 23<sup>rd</sup>- 29<sup>th</sup>)

Christmas & New Year's Break (December 22<sup>nd</sup>- January 5<sup>th</sup>)

Spring Break (dates to be determined)

Two weeks (teacher vacation; advanced notice will be given)

# How do I pay my tuition?

Tuition is paid online at <u>stephankane.com/lessons</u>. Monthly memberships include automatic monthly payments on the same day of each month that your first payment was made until cancelled (see "Discontinuing Lessons" below for cancellation procedures).

## What does my tuition pay for?

- Lesson time
- Transportation to the student's home within San Francisco (if applicable)\*
- Preparation for each lesson
- Printed materials

(Please Note: book fees and guitar accessories are not included in the monthly tuition)

\*An additional transportation fee will be added to student's tuition invoice for in-home lessons *outside* of San Francisco.

#### **Tuition Rates**

My studio runs 46 weeks out of the year (1 week off at Thanksgiving, 2 weeks off at Christmas & New Year's, and 2 weeks off to be used at my discretion). Tuition is a **flat monthly fee**. Most months have four (4) lessons and some months have five (5) lessons, which act like a "bonus lesson." Some months have less than 4 lessons where holidays and breaks occur. In any case, it evens out to have 46 lesson weeks per year. Tuition is calculated as follows:

30-minute lessons: \$195 per month (\$50 lesson rate)

45-minute lessons: \$250 per month (\$65 lesson rate)

60-minute lessons: \$310 per month (\$80 lesson rate)

Tuition calculation: lesson rate x 46 weeks ÷ 12 months

# Make-up Policy & Rescheduling

No calls/no shows will forfeit their lesson and payment will not be refunded.

A student will be granted make-up credit when each of the following are met:

- 1.) 24-hour notice is given directly by email. There are no exceptions.
- 2.) The student must notify me of their desired make-up slot using the make-up calendar:

While you are actively taking lessons with me, make-up credit does not expire. Students are permitted to double up on lessons during a single week with the understanding that the student is expected to practice more to make the lesson time productive and worthwhile. However, taking lessons two days in a row is perfectly fine for the student. Students are allowed one lesson per day, whether it is a make-up lesson or a regular scheduled lesson.

I schedule a few make-up slots during the week as a courtesy to my students. I am aware that things come up unexpectedly and sometimes it is necessary for you to cancel a lesson. Make-up slots are on a first come, first served basis. If a lesson is cancelled with 24-hour notice, another student may use that time slot for their make-up lesson that week. Accordingly, you are entitled to use another student's regular lesson time slot as a make-up if they cancel and the calendar will updated regularly.

All make-up lessons will be offered over Zoom video. If I have to cancel a lesson, I will reach out to you with at least 24-hour notice to reschedule. If I need to cancel within 24-hours before your lesson, you will have the option to either schedule a make-up lesson or be credited that lesson for the following month.

I do not provide tuition refunds under any circumstances.

## Discontinuing lessons\*

Everyone's musical journey includes change – if guitar lessons are not the right fit for you or if for some reason you need to stop taking lessons with me, please let me know. I am completely supportive of doing what is best for my students.

- \*At least a **14-day written notice** is required <u>before</u> the next automatic payment occurs on your card in order to cancel lessons and avoid being billed for the next payment cycle. All make-up credit will be forfeited at the time of cancellation.
  - 1.) Cancellation will be effective as of the next monthly payment is due. You may withdraw the cancellation at any time before it takes effect, but your lesson time slot cannot be guaranteed.
  - 2.) Tuition is not transferable.
  - 3.) I do not provide tuition refunds under any circumstances.\*
  - 4.) \*I reserve the right to terminate membership at any time, in which case prorated tuition will be refunded.

With permission, I post pictures and videos of what my students are learning and accomplishing. Students will only be identified by their first name. If you would not like your picture or your child's picture online, please let me know.

# Parent Involvement

During lessons, I spend one-on-one time with your child to prepare them for a week of practice; however, individual practice time will be most effective when parent accountability is involved.

Please set aside a few minutes each week to check in on your child's practice sessions and make sure they are developing effective practice habits.

## Ideas for practice accountability:

- Set a timer that you/your child can see as a count-down during practice
- Have your child perform mini "recitals" for siblings or other family members
- Sit with your child one practice session a week. Give your child the opportunity to teach you the materials they are learning and ask questions as if you are the student.

# 2020 – 2021 Studio Policy & Procedures

## Illness and general safety:

If a student is ill on the day of their *in-person* lesson, the student must either cancel their lesson or request to have it over Zoom. I reserve the right to stop any in-person lesson if my safety feels threatened for any reason, including if I deem that the student may be contagious, in which case the student forfeits the lesson. Precautionary measures may be implemented for in-person lessons, such as maintaining a distance of at least 6 feet apart, conducting the lesson outdoors, and requiring masks to be worn by all parties for the duration of our meeting.
